

Linked Data

Uniform Resource Identifiers (URIs) in GPO's Bibliographic Records





URIs added

- URI = Uniform Resource Identifier
- Enables linked data among institutions
- Added for authorized access points in bibliographic records
 - Connects to the associated authority record
- Close to 5 million URIs added to the <u>Catalog of U.S.</u> <u>Government Publications (CGP)</u>

Impact of URIs added

- Imperfect machine matching
- Some mismatches (mostly for personal names)
- Need to prevent mismatches
- Re-evaluated GPO policy to limit creation of personal name authority records (NARs)
- Less robust NARs for some persons

Library of Congress Subject Headings





Types of subject authority headings (+ examples)

- Buildings/Structures
 - J. Edgar Hoover Building (Washington, D.C.)
 - Patterson-McDermott Cabin (Skagway, Alaska)

- Geographic features
 - Little Black River Watershed (Ark. and Mo.)
 - Manhattan Project National Historical Park

- Events
 - Hurricane Irma, 2017
 - Mobile Campaign, 1865

- Topical concepts
 - Digital currency
 - Off-label drug use





Proposing headings

- GPO is a member of SACO (Subject Authority Cooperative Program), a component of PCC (The Program for Cooperative Cataloging)
- SACO members can submit proposals for additions and changes to LCSH
- Most GPO proposals are reviewed internally before submission
- All proposals are reviewed for editorial consistency by staff at the Library of Congress, with community input





Considerations before proposal

- Is there any subject in the work being cataloged that cannot be covered by existing LCSH?
- Does the subject comprise at least 20% of the work?
- Is the subject a discrete, identifiable concept?
- Could the subject term from the work be a synonym or variant for an existing LCSH?






LCSH created by GPO

- Appalachian Development Highway System
- Blended wing-body aircraft
- Consolidation of gains (Military science)
- Emtricitabine/tenofovir disoproxil fumarate
- FedNow Service (Service mark)


- Indium tin oxide
- Town Creek Aqueduct (Md.)
- X-34 (Research plane)
- Yermo xanthocephalus
- Zumwalt Class (Destroyers)





When are change proposals needed?

- Main heading needs replacement because it is offensive and/or out-of-date
- Synonyms are discovered and must be added
- The hierarchy needs to be adjusted
- A reciprocal scope note is needed for an existing heading, to differentiate it from a new but similar subject





Changes initiated by GPO

Changes to main heading:

- Problem youth --> At-risk youth (Social sciences)
- Protective clothing --> Personal protective equipment



Changes by GPO

Addition of cross references:

- + Private activity bonds (Industrial development bonds) for Industrial development bonds
- + Residential reentry centers for Halfway houses





SACO monthly review process

- <u>Tentative List</u>*
- Editorial Meeting
- <u>Summary of Decisions</u>*
- *Freely available online or sign up for the <u>SACO listserv</u> to receive via email

Tentative monthly lists

- Proposed headings scheduled for review
- Headings are not yet approved or available for use in current cataloging
- <u>Anyone</u> can submit comments to argue for or against proposals on the list
- List date is when it will be discussed and reviewed





Monthly editorial meeting

- <u>Open</u> to interested members of the library community and the public at large
- Held once a month on Fridays
- Discussion to consider any of the subject proposals on the current monthly list

Monthly editorial meeting

- 2022 discussions:
 - Digital undertakers and undertaking
 - Mass incarceration
 - White privilege
 - Non-standard employment
 - Urban indigenous peoples
 - Manga





Summary of Decisions

- Summary of Decisions is usually released around 2 weeks after the Editorial Meeting
- Announcement of proposals that were not approved as submitted, with justifications from the deciding committee
- May also include announcements about large scale or systematic changes to groups of headings





GPO's LCSH proposals for 2022 so far

- More than 40 new headings
- Approx. 1 dozen updated headings

Bibliographic Framework Initiative Partnership with the Library of Congress






BIBFRAME

- <u>https://www.loc.gov/bibframe/</u>
- Developed by the Library of Congress
- Linked Data cataloging model
 - Relies on URIs
- Replacement/Alternative to MARC 21
- Not *in*compatible with RDA, but not a straightforward match

BIBFRAME Partnership: Statistics

- 70+ questions asked (& answered by LC staff!)
- 26 Work, 31 Instance records completed
- Record types:
 - monograph, multipart monograph, serial, integrating resource
 - map, hearing, public law, foreign language, bilingual, streaming video, braille
 - print format, electronic format





BIBFRAME Partnership: Outcome

- LTS gained firsthand experience with BIBFRAME
- LTS provided LC with an "outsider" perspective
- Marva and public-facing database are still in development
- LC network staff are continually making changes based on cataloger feedback





BIBFRAME: Next steps

- LSCM will need to decide whether/when to implement
- Decisions will need to be made for elements unique to Government documents





RDA

Resource Description and Access





Official RDA

- a.k.a. "New RDA"
- Launched December 15, 2020
- Now in use worldwide
- Not yet adopted by the Program for Cooperative Cataloging (PCC)
 - Not yet adopted by GPO
 - Original RDA is still valid





Official RDA

- New & different features for PCC
 - Revised LC-PCC PS (Library of Congress Program for Cooperative Cataloging Policy Statements)
 - Newly created MGDs (<u>Metadata Guidance</u> <u>Documentation</u>)






PCC Test of the Official RDA Toolkit

PCC Test of the Official RDA Toolkit

- Testing LC-PCC PS and MGDs for accuracy and usability
 - 1 LTS Technical Services Librarian tester
 - 1 LTS Metadata Integrity Librarian evaluator
- Designed by <u>PCC Task Group to Test the Official RDA Toolkit</u>
 - 1 LTS Metadata Integrity Librarian on Task Group





PCC Test of the Official RDA Toolkit

- Testing period: Oct. 17 Jan. 6, 2023
- Task Group will analyze data and provide recommendations to PCC in early 2023
- PS and MGDs will be updated based on recommendations
- Official RDA will be implemented by PCC no sooner than June 2023
