- The 2022 Community Award for Professional Development was presented to Bob Cullen.



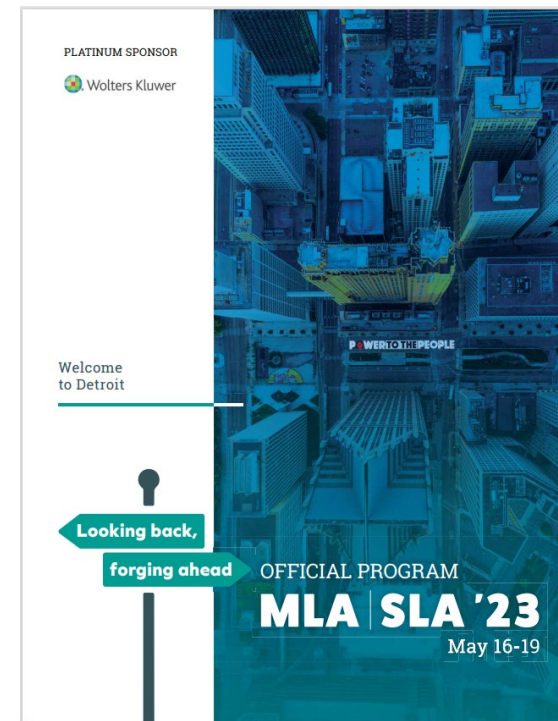
