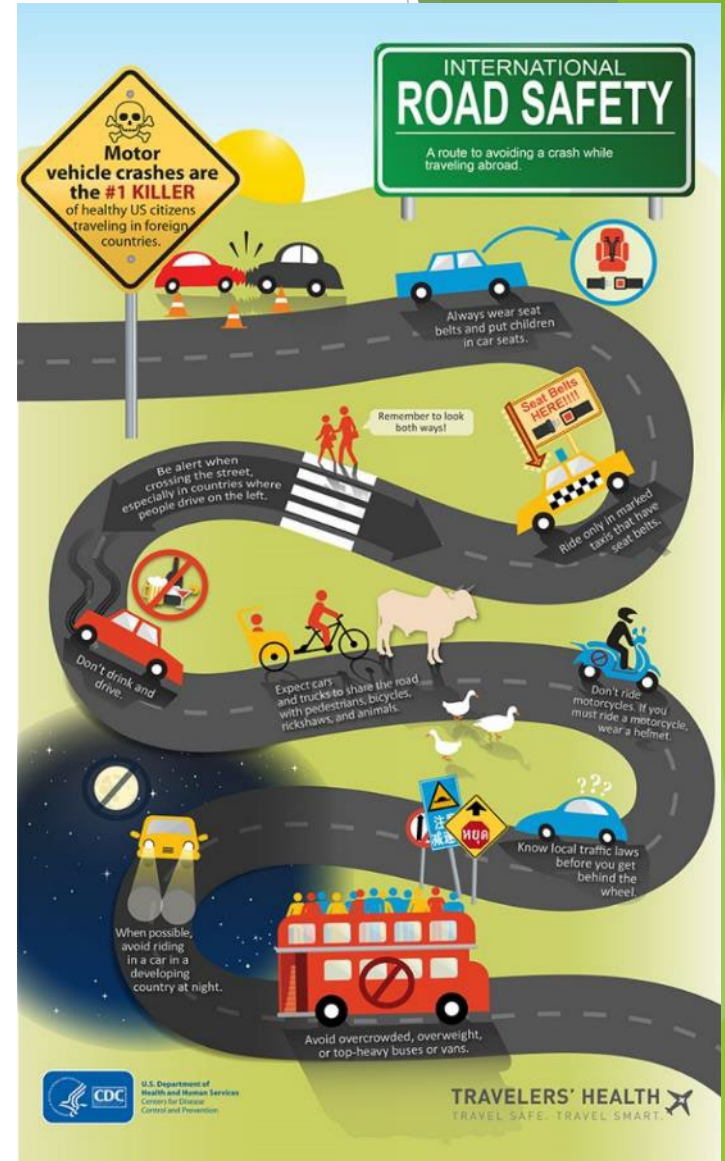

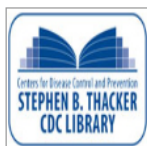

*Disposition to be made of infected vessels arriving at ports where there are no appliances for proper disinfection.*

WASHINGTON, July 28, 1894.

SIR: I would respectfully inform you that the local quarantine at Rockland, Me., has been inspected by Passed Assistant Surgeon J. H. White, M. H. S., and report of said inspection made to the Supervising Surgeon-General, to the effect that there are no facilities for the disinfection of infected vessels which might arrive at that port, required under the Quarantine Regulations of the United States, approved April 26, 1894.

You are informed that infected vessels arriving at any port within your collection district requiring disinfection under the Quarantine Regulations of the United States will be remanded to some other port for disinfection, in accordance with section 6 of the act granting additional quarantine powers and imposing additional duties upon the Marine-Hospital Service, approved February 15, 1893.

You will report by telegraph to the Supervising Surgeon-General of the Marine-Hospital Service the arrival of any infected vessel within your collection district.

Your attention is also called to that part of section 5 of the National Quarantine Act, above referred to, regarding the health certificate to be furnished by the health officer, and to Article I (Inspection), Quarantine Regulations to be observed at ports and on the frontiers of the United States, dated April 26, 1894.

## Dangers of distracted driving

- Distracted driving crashes killed more than 3,000 people and injured 416,000 in 2010.
- Reaction time is delayed for a driver talking on a cell phone as much as it is for a driver who is legally drunk.
- More texting leads to more crashes. With each additional 1 million text messages, fatalities from distracted driving rose more than 75%.
- People under the age of 20 are involved in more fatal crashes due to distractions than any other age group.
- Studies show that drivers who send or receive text messages focus their attention away from the road for an average of 4.6 seconds. At 55 mph, this is equivalent to driving the length of a football field blindfolded!

Real-time context aware computing techniques facilitate construction personnel with supplementary information that can potentially help them in taking and recognizing potentially hazardous situations. This paper presents a framework for developing real-time monitoring systems and demonstrates the use of placing embeds into reinforced concrete railway bridge decks. The problem of placing embeds into reinforced concrete structures, including imaging reinforcement bars (rebar), is an industry-wide challenge encountered across the construction industry. In concrete structures such as bridges and post-tensioned concrete floors, damaging rebar may compromise structural integrity and result in considerable rework. This paper presents and implements conceptual solutions for processing and incorporating point cloud data obtained from various 3D imaging technologies. The 3D imaging technologies were used to map the locations of rebar within a replica of a section of a railway bridge deck. Once the point cloud data are safe for drilling are automatically detected and saved as a Building Information Model (BIM), which is then used to provide real-time feedback to the drill operator whether it is safe to continue drilling based on the position and orientation of the drill. A conceptual method for providing visual feedback to the drill operator using a laser projector was also developed and is also presented. 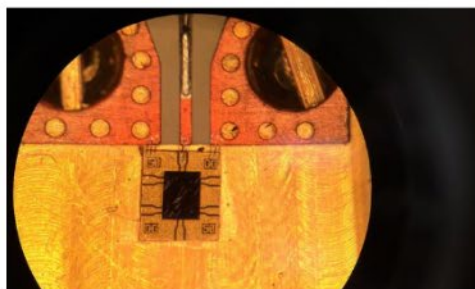

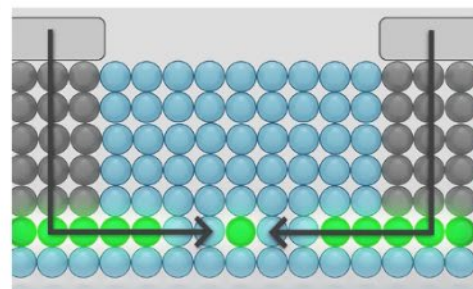

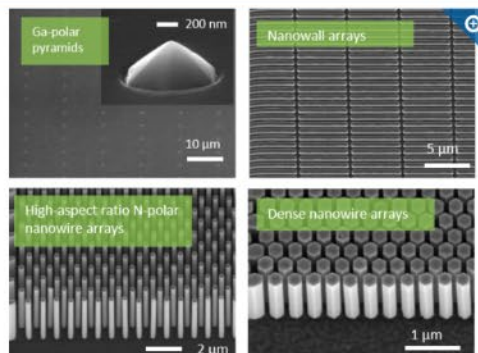
#### Summary

We synthesize semiconductor nanostructures to serve both as test structures for measurement techniques and as building blocks for novel metrology tools and devices, with a focus on GaN nanowires. We also adapt traditional methods of semiconductor characterization for use on nanostructures to evaluate accuracy and determine best practices for those methods, including Raman spectroscopy, photoluminescence, triple-axis x-ray diffraction, and electrical device fabrication and testing.

#### DESCRIPTION

##### Scanning probe metrology using

**GaN nanowire tips:** A major goal of our project is to develop new metrology tools for examining the optoelectronic properties of semiconductor nanostructures. We are currently developing GaN nanowires as multifunctional scanning probe tips, combining light emission, microwave reflection, and topology measurement. The nanowires have been shown to retain their shape indefinitely, thus they are more durable than standard glass near-field scanning optical microscopy (NSOM) tips and more reproducible than state-of-the-art Pt tips for near-field scanning microwave microscopy (NSMM). GaN nanostructure arrays with calibrated reference dimensions are available as

## Collections

The Linda Hall Library holds over half a million monograph volumes and more than 48,000 journal titles related to science, technology, engineering, and their histories. The Library's collections are exceptionally strong in the engineering disciplines, chemistry, and physics, but it also has impressive holdings in natural history, astronomy, environmental and earth sciences, aeronautics, life sciences, infrastructure studies, and mathematics. Thanks to longstanding exchange partnerships dating to before the Cold War, the Library retains large amounts of material related to science in Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union.

Beyond monographs and serials, the Library collects reference works, conference proceedings, government publications, technical reports, and unpublished engineering society conference papers. It maintains a collection over 200,000 industrial standards, many of which are unavailable elsewhere in the United States. The Linda Hall Library also has a substantial collection of patent literature and is an officially sanctioned [Patent and Trademark Resource Center](#).

Throughout its history, the Linda Hall Library has benefited from the acquisition of several historically significant collections.

In 1946, it purchased the entire library of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, including its rare books and extensive collection of scientific periodicals, pamphlets, and reprints. In 1985, the Franklin Institute transferred hundreds of its serial titles to Kansas City. A decade later, the Library absorbed the collections of the Engineering Societies Library, obtaining a nearly comprehensive set of publications from its five founding organizations:

- American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE)
- American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME)
