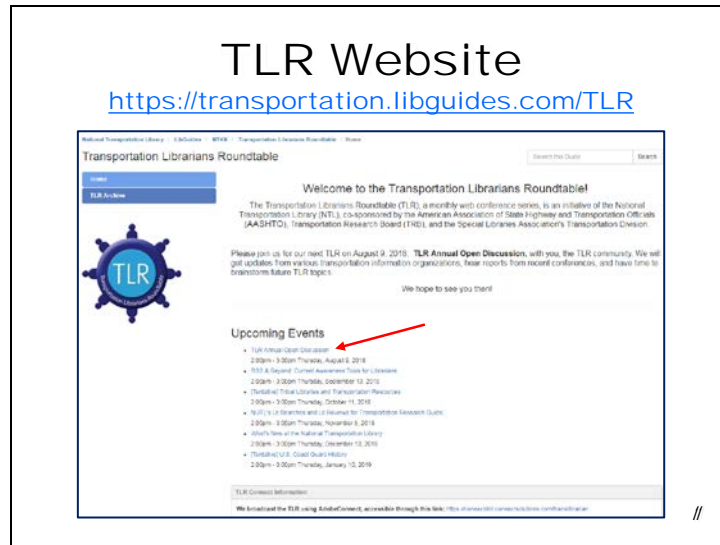

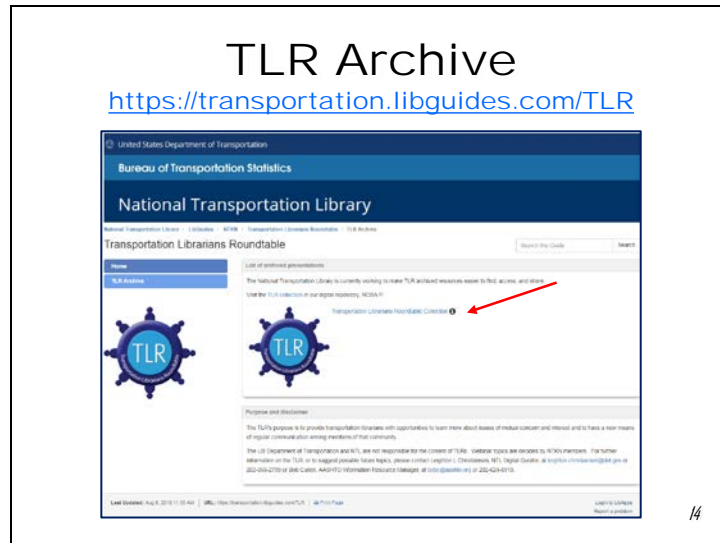




Samantha

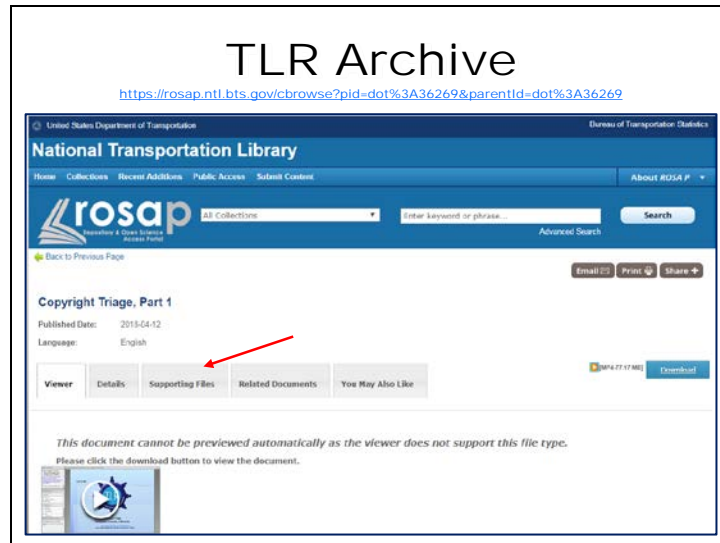
